**DISTRICT AND TOWN/PARISH COUNCIL ELECTIONS**  
**WILL TAKE PLACE**

1 - In accordance with LGA 1972 ss9(1) and 27(1) in a parish or community every elector may exercise direct authority by speaking and voting at electors' meeting. In addition, where he or she, or is represented upon, a local council, he may vote in elections of local councillors. No one is entitled to exercise either of these rights unless his name appears in the appropriate electoral register (Representation of the People's Act 1983, s2), but a properly qualified person has an enforceable right to have his name placed upon the register if it has been wrongly omitted therefrom (Representation of the People's Act 1983, s4)
