**0581 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING**

**0584 RESOLUTION TO BORROW**

It was RESOLVED to seek the approval of the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government to apply for a PWLB of £160,000 over the borrowing term of 25 years for the replacement Skate Park. The annual loan repayments will come to around £6,400. It is not intended to increase the Council Tax Precept for the purpose of the loan repayments. Proposed by Councillor Tudgay, seconded by Councillor Hearne. Vote: Unanimous.

**0585 OPEN SPACES REPORT**

The Clerk met with the Tree Surgeon to discuss the tree work required at the Churchyard. The Clerk spoke about the possibility of fishing at the Recreation Ground. Council agreed to contact CATCH for more information.

**0586 COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT POLICY**

On a proposal from Councillor Cook, seconded by Councillor Tudgay, Council voted unanimously to adopt the Community Engagement Policy. The Chairman talked about Councillors getting together before the next meeting to talk about better ways of communicating with the community.
